LNJNI NICFS is pleased to announce that the Ministry of Home Affairs has approved the Proposal for Award of Merit Scholarship and Scholar Book Grant for the students of M.A. Criminology and M.Sc. Forensic Science to promote study of Criminology and Forensic Science at Post Graduate level.

The scholarship has been divided into 2 categories:

Scheme A – LNJNI NICFS Merit and Means Scholarship

Scheme B – LNJNI NICFS Scholar Book Grant

LNJN NICFS Scholarships: Eligibility Criteria and Conditions

The Number of Scholarships, Eligibility Criteria and Conditions are given below:-

Number of Scholarships

Scholarships are divided into 2 categories i.e. Scheme-A and Scheme-B. Students can avail either of the 2 scholarships:

Scheme – A: LNJNI NICFS Merit and Means Scholarship

Scheme – B: LNJNI NICFS Scholar Book Grant

Course	Year	No. of Merit and Means Scholarship (Scheme-A)	No. of Scholar Book Grant (Scheme-B)
M.A. Criminology	Frist Year	6	6
M.Sc. Forensic Science	First Year	6	6
M.A. Criminology	Second Year	6	6
M.Sc. Forensic Science	Second Year	6	6

Number of Scholarships in each Scheme = 24 per Scheme (maximum per year)

Out of 06 Scholarships in each course category, the distribution will be on the following basis:

- (1) **Merit Scholarship:** 2 Scholarships purely on merit basis.
General category - 01 and SC/ST/OBC category- 01.
- (2) **Merit cum Means Scholarship:** 4 Scholarships on merit cum means basis in case where the annual income of the parents/guardian does not exceed Rs. 5 Lakh.
General Category- 02 and SC/ST/OBC category- 02.

The Scholarship would rotate between SC/ST/OBC candidates on rotation basis. For the 1st year of award, the Scholarship would go to candidates of the category having highest percentage of marks. The category left out will be considered next year and the roster would move accordingly. However, if sufficient numbers of SC/ST/OBC students are not available, the scholarship shall be awarded to candidate of General category.

Scheme – A: LNJNI NICFS Merit and Means Scholarship

Financial assistance available under the Scheme-A will be Rs. 2000/- p.m. for 12 months. The scholarship shall be released in quarterly installments on production of certificate of prescribed minimum attendance of 75% (barring exceptional circumstances on Medical ground supported by Medical Certificate to the satisfaction of the Director, NICFS) and securing 60% marks for General category and 55% of SC/ST/OBC category in first/third semester examinations (as applicable).

Eligibility Criteria

(i) For first year students of M.A. Criminology/M.Sc. Forensic Science.

The criterion of first year scholarship is purely the Common Entrance Test (CET) rank conducted by GGSIP for the M.A. Criminology and M.Sc. Forensic Science subject.

(ii) For second year students of M.A. Criminology/M.Sc. Forensic Science

Students from M.A. Criminology and M.Sc. Forensic Science who scored maximum marks in the first and second semester examinations collectively (declared by GGSIP) will be awarded scholarship provided they have cleared all the subjects in both the semester.

Scheme – B: LNJNI NICFS Scholar Book Grant

Financial assistance available under the scheme will be Rs. 10000/- per annum for the purchase of books. The books may be purchase in printed or electronic form. The book grant will be given to the students only on submission of receipts of books purchased provide that the receipts are countersigned by any faculty member of NICFS. In addition, the books need to be relevant to the subject they are enrolled in the Institute. Relevancy of a book is also to be approved by a faculty member.

Eligibility Criteria

(i) For first year students of M.A. Criminology/M.Sc. Forensic Science

The criterion of first year scholarship is purely the Common Entrance Test (CET) rank conducted by GGSIP for the M.A. Criminology and M.Sc. Forensic Science subject.

(ii) For second year students of M.A. Criminology/M.Sc. Forensic Science.

Criteria for award would be merit among applicants based on marks secured in the first and second semester examinations collectively (declared by GGSIP). The students will be awarded scholarship provided they have cleared all the subjects in both the semester.

Conditions


- For first year students:
 - If found ineligible, the applicant next in merit will be considered for the scholarship.
 - In case of tie of marks, the one having higher marks in under-graduate level will be given priority.
 - A self-attested copy of the CET rank (GGSIP) has to be submitted along with the application form.
- The second year students:
 - The students must maintain the minimum satisfactory performance i.e. 60% in third semester examinations for General category candidates and 55% for the SC/ST/OBC candidates.
 - In case of a tie of marks (total of 1st and 2nd semester examinations), the one having higher combined attendance in theory plus practical classes will be given preference.
 - Copies of self-attested mark sheets of 1st and 2nd semester have to be submitted along with the application form.
- The Students must not be getting stipend/Scholarship/financial assistance under any other scheme of Central or State Government. They are to submit an undertaking for the same.
- Students applying under the Merit cum Means Scholarship will be eligible if the annual income of the parents/guardian does not exceed Rs. 5 Lakh. A certificate of income of parents/guardian, obtained from and duly attested by the employer has to be submitted along with the application; otherwise an application under this Category will not be entertained.
- In case parents/guardian is in private business, a self-attested copy of Income Tax Return (Financial Year 2015-16) has to be submitted with the application form.
- Self-attested caste certificate for SC/ST/OBC issued by the Authorized Authorities is to be submitted along with application form.


Cancellation of Scholarship


- A. Misconduct of the awardee, if any reported to the Institution.
- B. Unsatisfactory progress report, if the candidate scores less than 60% or 55% in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates in the first semester and third semester of the Master degree program.
- C. If the information/certificates submitted by the student are found to be incorrect/false, the scholarship is liable for cancellation (including forfeiture of amount already released) and penal action as per law.

The application form is available from Teaching Section, NICFS and also uploaded on the NICFS website www.nicfs.nic.in. The students have to submit the duly filled application form latest by 15th November, 2016 to Sh. Manit Kumar, Teaching Section and obtain the acknowledgment of receipt of the same. No application will be received after the due date 15th November, 2016
